



# Bulk-R™

### GENERAL INFORMATION:

**Bulk-R** is an advanced generation of plant nutrients to enhance nutrient availability and uptake by the plants. It contains natural growth promoters, enzyme precursors and nutrients essential for stimulating root growth and fruit bulking. **Bulk-R** is a blend of water-soluble plant nutrients for efficient crop use and provides nutrients in a readily available form.

### GUARANTEED ANALYSIS:

Soluble Potash ( $K_2O$ ) ..... 5.0%

Derived from potassium carbonate.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

**Bulk-R** plant nutrients are recommended for use on all plants. **Bulk-R** is intended to supplement and enhance a full fertilization program as recommended in accordance with a reliable Soil and Tissue Analysis. **Bulk-R** provides a source of immediately available nutrients but will not, by itself, provide all necessary nutrients required during the growing season. **Bulk-R** is designed for foliar application and injection through chemigation and sprinkler systems.

**All Applications:** **Bulk-R** should **NOT** be applied with any other mineral based product, but rather alone to achieve full effectiveness and avoid interfering with its mode of action. **Mix with water ONLY.**

**Aerial Application:** Apply the recommended amount of **Bulk-R** in a minimum of 3 gallons water per acre.

**Foliar Application:** Apply the recommended amount of **Bulk-R** in at least 10 gallons water per acre.

**Potatoes and Sugarbeets:** Apply 1 gallon per acre 30 to 40 days prior to harvest.

**Row Crops:** Apply 1 gallon per acre at early filling stage.

**Field and Vegetable Crops:** Apply at the rate of 1 gallon per acre at post-bloom or early fruiting.

**Compatibility:** **Bulk-R** is compatible with most fungicides and registered insecticides. However, a compatibility jar test and small plot test is recommended before large-scale treatments are started. Always refer to product label. **DO NOT** mix with any nutrient program.
